Inv.-Nr. C.68, French prisoner of war bone ship model. 4th rate 50 gun frigate. About 1800:

Inv.-Nr. C.70, French prisoner of war bone ship model. 3 masted 5th rate frigate carrying 38 guns. Well carved deck fittings and quarter galleries with later rigging. Figurehead gold painted Roman soldier. About 1800:

Inv.-Nr. C.71, French prisoner of war bone ship model. "Victory". 2nd rate, 84th gun ship of the line on stand covered with strips of bone. Figurehead of a black female. Late 18th/ early 19th century:

Inv.-Nr. C.72, French prisoner of war carved bone ship model. 1st rate, 110 gun ship of the line on mirror base. Retracting cannon, boars slung over port and starboard sides, lifeboat mounted on davits astern. Figurehead of person with dagger. About 1800:

Inv.-Nr. C.73, French prisoner of war 3 masted ship model. 3rd rate, 78 gun ship of the line, on wooden base with gallery. Figurehead of a Tudor man looks similar to Henry VIII. Late 18th/early 19th century:



Inv.-Nr. C.81, Waterline model of 3 masted sailing vessel, mid 19th Century, in wood and bone. Bone hatched masts and spars, mahogany plinth. Under glass dome. Mid 19th Century:



Inv.-Nr. C.89, Model of a 4 masted barque, the "Herzogin Cecilie" Made by a sailor. Grey hull, green below waterline. Some bone pieces in rigging and anchor:
